
### A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR SCOTT MCDERMOTT

### **School Overview**

The Crossing School of Supernatural Ministry has partnered with Missio Global School of Ministry and Summit Bible College to offer an exciting program for ministry training. The students in CSSM now have some options in their training goals. First, they can complete the standard program and receive a diploma from CSSM/Missio Global. This program includes a one year basic option and a three year diploma of ministry. Second, a student can choose the "Degree Version" of the CSSM/Missio program. A student can choose the Associates Dearee option or a Bachelors Degree option, which are approved through Summit Bible College.

If you already have a Bachelor or Master's Degree and desire an advanced degree in ministry, CSSM 3rd year graduates are eligible to enter a Master's or Doctoral program at Summit Bible College, upon the approval of the college, with reduced course requirements.

### Vision and Mission

The Crossing School of Supernatural Ministry exists to train leaders who will powerfully and effectively minister in their God-given gifts and calling. Based at The Crossing and supported by The Crossing leadership, we follow the model of Jesus who trained and sent His twelve into the mission field. Our school exists to train leaders:

- To be sent out as church planters
- To serve as pastors and church staff members
- To be sent out from our church as home-based and international missionaries

### **Curriculum Overview**

More than a course in theology, The Crossing School of Supernatural Ministry focuses on practical Christian ministry. The curriculum is based on three domains of ministry training: Knowledge of the Bible (Knowing), Ministry Skills (Doing), and Personal Spiritual Formation (Being). Each module falls principally into one of these three domains, with every quarter including a module from each of the three domains.

#### Schedule

There are thirty-six modules (subjects), twelve per year. Classes meet once a week for three hours. Each quarter includes three modules. As such, twelve modules (subjects) are completed each year. Students also complete related ministry projects in their local churches.

Classes are held at The Crossing on Monday nights from 6:30 - 9:30pm, as well as some Saturdays.
